I would estimate the cab fee would be about \$20, and the shuttle is about \$17 round trip.

# Rules and Regulations

## Name Badges

Attendees must wear their name badges at all times to gain admittance to any and all functions. If you do not have your name badge, not only will you be turned away from events so you can go back to your room to get it....we'll also make you eat in the lobby or restroom on a snack tray.

## Access to Convention

Only individuals registered for the convention are allowed at the convention functions. An exception is salesroom access for a convention dealer's non-registered helper. They will have a salesroom helper name badge granting them access. All others will be shot and quartered on site.

## Cancellations

There will be a \$50.00 cancellation fee for anyone who cancels before June 1, 2012. After June 1, 2012, no part of the registration money will be returned and no convention goodies or souvenir doll will be mailed out. We have to make money some way, since we already ordered all your meals and things, and the homeless are real fussy!

## Convention Souvenirs

In order to receive convention souvenirs, including but not limited to the convention doll, attendees MUST be present at the convention events at the time souvenirs are given out. No asking around what the goodies are so if you think they're junk you'll stay away to play the slot machines. No one who has made early flights so that they have to leave the convention early will receive their souvenir doll and it will not be mailed. Buck the traffic just like everyone else has to do, no thinking you're special. Remember those that leave parties early get talked about.

## Pets

Pets are not permitted at any convention function. An exception is made for dogs assisting persons with special needs. Also if your mate has been called a dog, rat, snake, weasel or whatever, they will only be permitted at the events if they are a registered attendee, can speak English (or foreign language) and can prove they can pee without lifting one leg.

## Cameras and Filming

It is advised that you bring your cameras and video equipment to take home some memories of a special time and new friends.....not to mention the wild costumes.

Stealing is not acceptable at the IFDC. You've seen the display at the 2008 IFDC!!!!

No cranky a\*\*es and snobs are allowed at the IFDC. If you're one of those, please leave the attitudes home and just come expecting to have a fun time....so everyone else can have a fun time also. Little goofs are fine....but no major, continuous, annoying attitudes allowed.

Please keep the attitudes in check. Already some companies have reported seeing nasty posts on boards and they reserve the right to keep those posting nasty remarks about them from attending their seminars or possibly the convention.

## Safety

Please remember safety at the convention, and the IFDC is not responsible for injuries at the convention. Please be aware of your surroundings, especially those with motorized wheelchairs....we are not responsible for tire marks on your butts!
